Very popular for building waste such as concrete, rubble and soil but this 6 cubic yard skip is also a handy size for medium amounts of general household waste. Some of the skips have drop doors for quick and easy access.

8 yards<sup>3</sup> - £370.00 plus VAT; £444.00 incl. VAT

A good skip choice for house clearances and larger loads of household waste. It is often selected by builders for light waste.

6 Yard Skip – General Waste - £286.00 plus VAT; £343.20 Incl. VAT

Our 6 Yard General Waste Skip can be used for trade or residential use and is ideal for medium household refits or clear-outs. Perhaps Kitchen, Bathroom, Garage or Garden clearance.

A 6 Yard Skip is the largest skip for heavy waste e.g. brick and soil waste. Good for bulky waste and small gardening jobs.

8 Yard Skip – General Waste - £346.50 plus VAT; £415.80 Incl. VAT;

Our 8 Yard General Waste Skip can be used for trade or residential use and is ideal for larger household refits or clear-outs. Perhaps Kitchen, Bathroom, Garage or Garden clearance.

An 8 Yard Skip is normally referred to as a builders skip but is also ideal for general house clearance. Good for bulky waste jobs.

NOTES:

Skip deliveries will be carried out between 7am and 7pm unless a specific time slot has been confirmed in advance.

You will receive a notification on the day of delivery, advising of a 2-hour window for delivery.

You do not need to be present for delivery -If you have any specific instructions with regards to access or positioning of the Skip on delivery, please advise at the point of ordering.

Upon our arrival, if we cannot carry out the Skip delivery for reasons beyond our control, wasted journey charges may apply.

The Skip delivery vehicle requires 9.5ft clearance to fulfil the delivery.

If we're unable to drop within the grounds of your property, you will require a Skip permit, lighting and signage. Don't worry, the Mick George Group will take care of all of this – simply let us know if the Skip is to be situated on public land, and we will arrange the rest. For more information, see our downloads tab below.

During Winter months, deliveries may still be completed after sunset. It is the responsibility of the customer to advise us if there is NOT adequate lighting for completing the delivery safely, otherwise wasted journey charges may apply.

Any prohibited items that are disposed of in your Skip that fall outside of the applicable materials listed, may incur additional charges or result in your Skip not being collected until the associated wasted journey charges are paid.

All skips must be level loaded with inert skips limited to 3/4 full.

£15 cancellation charges apply for skips cancelled after booking.

The 6 yard "builders" skip is often hired for slightly bulkier inert waste such as soil, concrete or other builders waste, as well as larger loads from domestic projects or garden waste. Its size is equivalent to 50-60 standard bin bags.

8 Yard Skip - £371.00 + VAT; £445.20 Incl. VAT

Max Hire Period: 2 Weeks

The 8 Yard "Builders" skip is often hired for bulky waste and larger loads from large domestic projects. Its size is equivalent to 70-80 standard bin bags. The 8 Yard skip is our most popular for bulky waste.

### NOTES:

A Skip placed OFF-ROAD is situated either on private land or a driveway.

A Skip placed ON-ROAD will be on public land such as footpaths and highways. In this situation a Road Permit will be required, usually at an extra cost.

It usually takes between 1 to 5 working days to collect your skip from when your collection request is placed with us. This can include prebooked collection dates too although we do try our utmost to collect on the pre-booked date. However we cannot guarantee a collection on this date.

During very busy periods, it can take 7 or 18 working days to collect your skip.

From 1st September 2023, The Environment Agency implemented a set of new guidelines for the handling of wood waste.

Wood that is dated from 2007 onwards CAN be placed in our skips.

Any wood dated between 1950 to 2007 will be classed as Hazardous and CANNOT be placed in our skips

Whenever a skip is to be placed on a public highway including footpath berms, and the highway and council land. Most local councils will require a road permit to be issued. Permits can be arranged for a maximum of 28 days and at extra cost. In most cases our suppliers will be able to arrange a permit for you. In some areas, local councils require that the hirer (you) applies for the road permit before the undertaking of a skip booking. We will advise you during the booking process of these requirements.
