

## Questions Raised by a Member of the Public

I have a few questions I wish to raise with the council. I would be grateful if you could forward this email to all councillors with my name and details redacted.

Can you please confirm if the parish council bears the cost of the grass cutting the village hall field, and if so the annual cost.

Can you please give feedback from the Easter play group sessions held.

The Chair asked members of the public to state their name before speaking. The lady who spoke against the Sandhills Woodland purchase was not identified . I had never seen her at a meeting before . There needs to be consistency.

I believe there needs to be careful investigation into the fcs protection for parish council money. How is the CIL money protected? Whilst bankruptcy is unlikely, cyberattack is not.

Can a record of all councillors training be published. Also the induction training for new councillors. Do all councillors understand how the declaration of pecuniary interest relates to individuals and their businesses? It is a legal requirement .

Given the Parish council's commitment to speed controls in the village, I am astounded at the attitude of some councillors to the Community speed watch volunteers.
