Dear David,

Firstly, thank you to yourself and the Parish Council for the notice board at the top of Phase 1, it looks great.

Secondly, I wish it to be raised as an agenda item at the next Parish Council meeting about the dog waste situation at the 2 bin locations in Moorland Gate and the general lack of bins across the whole village.

As you will be aware the amount of footfall through the development has increased significantly and so has the dog traffic.

While many dog owners like us are responsible and dispose of the dog waste in the correct manner there are a minority that don't, please see the attached picture.

I would like to propose that as Moorland Gate is a publicly accessible area and usable by the whole village, that some of the CIL money is released to buy and install a better disposal solution and that the Parish Council contribute financially to the emptying of the bins, this is currently paid for by the residents service charge, the feeling is that this is unfair, as why should they be paying for the village to fill the bins and not contribute to getting them emptied?

The Council may say that this is not their responsibility, however the current situation is not acceptable from an environmental perspective, and as children from the village play in this area and have to walk to school past these bins, it isn't very nice and I hope that the Parish Council will see that this proposal is for the benefit of everybody that lives in the Village.
