Dear Mr. Richards,

I would be very grateful if you would add the following to the agenda for the next meeting:

I am trying to organise this year's rota for volunteers to look after the small flower bed outside Quantock Vale Surgery and the larger bed by the underpass and roundabout. We have a monthly rota when two or more volunteers weed the beds, prune and water the plants when necessary and also remove the garden waste. The work usually takes no more than a couple of hours. At the time of writing the months of July and October are vacant and we have no-one yet to take on March of next year. I would be very grateful to hear from anyone who is interested in helping.

In order to discourage the weeds it has been suggested we could apply a layer of bark chippings to both beds and I was hoping the Council might feel able to fund the purchase of 6 bags. The average price per bag seems to be about £13 so £80 should be sufficient.

I know how much we would all appreciate your help and thank you in advance.
