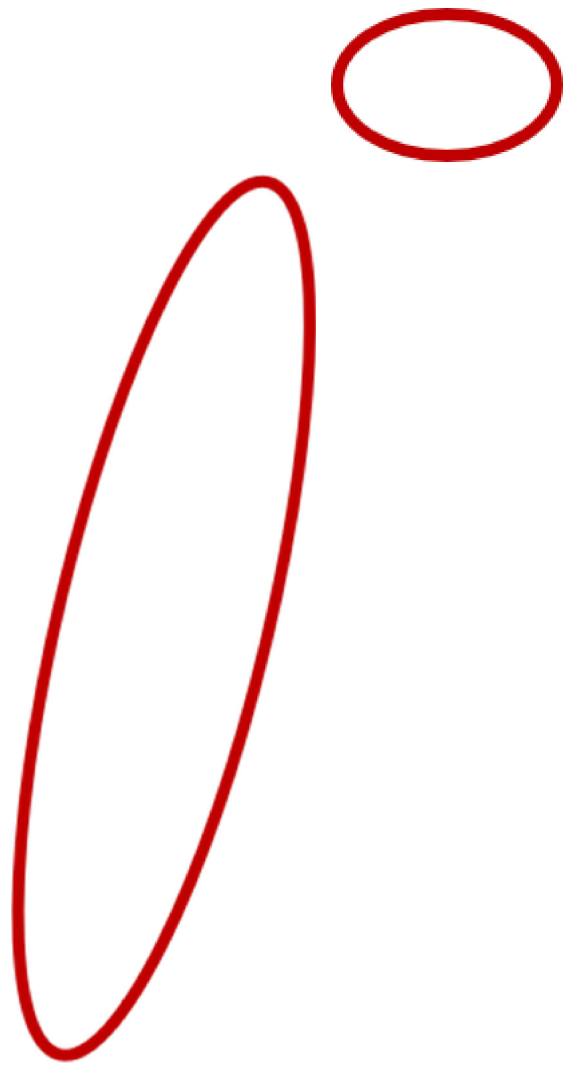
Hi David

Apologies for a bit of delay in sending information through, just realised the email was sat in my draft folder.

Thank you for kindly agreeing to organise a short pedestrian survey at High Street, where the proposed extension of virtual footway is leading to Delta Rise.

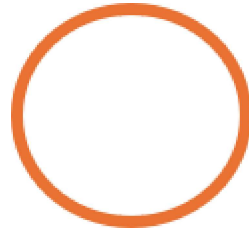
If possible, please can you capture people using the path off Pound Lane at the same time (see areas of interest circled in red below). I am mindful though that you may need a couple of people to be on site at the same time to undertake the survey in a safe manner to cover both locations, with one person observing High Street/ Cothelstone/Delta Rise (possibly in the nook at the northern side of Delta Rise junction – see location circled in orange below) and the other path off Pound Lane (by the path itself – see location circled in amber below).

Suggested observation locations:



We would require the data to be gathered at least for one weekday, between 8am-10am and 3pm-6pm, and if possible one weekend day (Saturday or Sunday, 10am-4pm) for a comparison on usage during the usual peak times. If you fancy to do 2 or 3 weekdays instead of one, it would be useful, but at least one weekday and one weekend day should be sufficient to get basic data to inform the virtual footway assessment. It would be great to have the survey results back by mid January 2026, if possible.

I attach the spreadsheet you can use to capture all the numbers (Ped Count tab)- if you can do classification (adult, school child, toddler, dog walker) it would be appreciated as it will give us a bit of idea who are the main users of the route as well. Please ignore cyclists, we are focusing purely on pedestrian movements in this case. I have greyed out within the spreadsheet times that survey is not required. Data is to be recorded in 15 minutes slots.

Finally, please could you make sure that anyone undertaking the survey is located safely off the carriageway, having a high viz on and the clothing suitable for the weather (considering that we are getting into wintertime). Obviously having a hot drink and a small chair to sit on as well, if that's a preference. Let me know if you need anything.
